In our recent video presentation to the HDN board, our clued up research and policy guy, Josh Neary-Pegler, suggested we talk more about



neurodiversity, and he has a good point. A neurodivergent individual is hard to spot, but the way they may think and learn, in different ways to others, can lead to exclusion.

Neurodiversity has a wide spectrum covering a range of conditions such as Autism, Dyslexia, Dyspraxia and Tourette's. Neurodiverse people might find their condition means they are better at some things, but often they need practical and emotional support to help them cope in work and social situations.

Josh has been leading HDN's new Health and Wellbeing group, alongside Fran Stulberg from <u>Riverside Group</u>, and that's just one forum where this under-the-radar section of society can find support and understanding.
