

## **Black Lives Matter**Through the eyes of a white woman

Another week, another killing in the USA and the Black Lives Matter movement still needs a wider audience.

There has been plenty of vocal and visual support from people in privileged positions; politicians, Premier League footballers and the West Indies cricket team. Taking the knee is a symbol, a powerful one...but we need real change throughout society.

At the Housing Diversity Network's Virtual Mentoring Celebration held on 3rd September Helen White, chief executive at Taff Housing Association, spoke emotively on the subject, saying: "I've always come from the standpoint that I value diversity and I don't see colour, but now I realise I need to go further.



"Our organisations have strategies in place, policies and warm words, but our board doesn't really reflect our customers and our communities. It isn't a great feeling when the penny drops... as a white woman."

Helen looks back to her childhood when she was old enough to venture out of the safety of home by herself; and her parents would say 'if you're in any trouble or need help find a policeman.'

Do parents of colour have that conversation with their own children?

Helen says: "We need to use our privilege to become an ally and tackle prejudice; we have big challenges and we must face them together."
