

COVID and Discrimination The pandemic continues to fuel inequality

'We're all in it together' was the mantra, back in March, when Rishi Sunak tried to bring the country together in the face of an unknown threat.

The Chancellor unveiled a mammoth fiscal package designed to keep the nation, its people and the economy on their feet. But our experience over the past six months has taught us that some of us are more 'in it' than others, and COVID-19 has turned out not to be a leveller, but a virus which can fuel inequality.

As always with this pandemic, the picture is moving rapidly and yesterday's SAGE communication indicated that we all face more challenges ahead. But the challenges are far from equally distributed.



Food for thought...

- The return of children to school in September did nothing to ease the pressure on women, who, according to the Institute for Fiscal Studies, were far more likely to be furloughed or lose their jobs.
- Figures published by the Office for National Statistics found that black people have been four times as likely to die of COVID-19 as white people of the same age.
- Research in the UK has found that two-thirds of people with visual impairments feel less independent since the outbreak of the virus.
