Course Information

The CMI Level 5 Award in Management Coaching and Mentoring is designed to support managers to develop management coaching and mentoring skills and to identify meaningful links between coaching, mentoring and the achievement of business goals. It provides a thorough grounding in the theory and practice of coaching and mentoring. It is also suitable for anyone wishing to develop these skills whilst working independently as a coach, consultant or facilitator. We teach this qualification in a business-oriented way, ensuring participants learn from first-hand coaching experience, as well as through taught material and written assignments. We include a level of required coaching practice and reflective review so that the Award is made up of three different elements:

- Attendance at six workshop sessions
- 10 hours supervised coaching and mentoring practice
- A 3000 3500 word written assignment from a choice of six units
- A 1000 1500 word reflective review and a personal development plan (PDP)

Level 5 covers practical skills and competencies that are rated in academic terms as being comparable to Foundation Degrees and Higher National Diplomas (HND). There is an expectation that participants will have the required academic and intellectual capabilities to write assignments at these levels.

Supervision

The Association of Coaching (AoC) recommends that coaches receive one hour of supervision for every 30 hours coaching. We know that trainees benefit from a greater level of supervision. Therefore, group and individual phone supervision are included within the programme.

Assignment Support

We offer flexible, 1-2-1 assignment support throughout the course. Most people appreciate this approach and find that checking in 'little and often' is the most helpful way to get assignments done!
