Whether it's social media posts by high profile figures, incidents of discrimination in the workplace, racial profiling, or the highlighting of systemic disparities in housing allocations or service delivery, the call always comes to us: why aren't you saying anything?

An immediate reaction to 'call it out' is the easy thing to do. It puts the focus solely on the individual or the organisations and it means that we overlook the broader societal factors at play. Putting the emphasis on societal issues, rather than individual or organisational culpability, is crucial in addressing racism effectively.
