Past CEO's and Chairs joined us in Westminster at our celebration where we presented certificates to our longest standing members.

Malta approved joining the European Union in a referendum, encouraged by its allies in the UK, who promptly voted to leave 13 years later!


Housing Assurance Board Member – 2 roles
