1.	Welcome and Introductions	
	Imtiaz Vohra (Chair) welcomed everyone to the meeting and introductions were made.	
2.	Previous Minutes of the meeting dated 4 December 2019	
	These were confirmed as a true record.	
3.	Matters arising from the Minutes	
	There was still some ongoing work on workforce statistics, which needed to be shared across the region.	
4.	Current Issues – Covid-19 and Black Lives Matter	
	The meeting discussed current issues of concern in the housing sector. The first of these was the Covid-19 pandemic, and how organisations had responded.	
	There was a lot of work ongoing on keeping services running and protecting the most vulnerable people. Almost all housing organisations were ringing round and ensuring that tenants' welfare was safeguarded.	

	There had been some uptake on the need for language services.	
	HDN was providing some resources to members in the form of webinars.	
	The BME Communities, Health and Housing Webinar had been well-received and the online training on Equality Impact Assessments is to commence shortly.	
	Further seminars to look at Covid-19 and Discrimination Law, and workplace and coming of the pandemic were planned.	
	The BLM protests in America, and now in Britain were discussed, and the response of the housing sector. Some associations had put messages out in support of the movement.	NAZ.
	HDN's position was elaborated, and had been put out on the website.	MK to send link
	Ravinder Kaur talked about the need to welcome a range of leadership styles to the organisation, not just outwardly assertive and aggressive ones. She was currently working on this.	
5.	Staff Mentoring Programme	
	Mushtaq Khan and Carla Olfin talked through HDN's flagship mentoring programme. Applications were now open for the 2020-21 intake, across the region, with a closing date of 31 July.	
	The programme had been very successful in recent years and HDN were recruiting both mentors and mentees.	
	Mentoring for up to 5 members of staff is included within the HDN Membership package. All members were encouraged to consider filling these places. The progamme is open to all staff across the board.	
	A webinar to discuss the programme in more detail will be on Wednesday 17th July.	
	A new HDN Associate Georgia Parker will be running the programme in the Midlands and a local lead was obviously a good development.	
5.	Board Diversity Programme	
	Yonne Davies discussed HDN's Board Diversity Programme.	
	A very successful pilot had been held in the North West and HDN were now looking to roll this out to a national cohort staring in September.	
	The programme was a strategic attempt to tackle the lack of diversity and was not a quick fix.	

	A number of organisations had expressed an interest in taking part in another programme and HDN were now following this up. HDN to produce some video clips of participants in both the staff mentoring and Board Diversity programmes.	со
