### RAFIQ'S WORDS STILL RESONATE

Here at the Housing Diversity Network we live and breathe our principles of Equality, Diversity and Inclusion; and we're part of a growing movement of people throughout the world who will stand up for our friends and colleagues whenever they are subjected to prejudice or unfairness.

Now, as much as any other time in our history, it is crucial that we all show caring and humility in our dealings with others, and so the plight of former Yorkshire cricketer Azeem Rafiq remains poignant. It is four months since he talked about the racism he suffered as a player at Yorkshire CCC, a seminal moment in the sport when the authorities finally seemed to face up to the reality of the bigotry which is all too often in evidence.

Rafiq expected a backlash and, depressingly, he has been proven correct. And while overt racism is the preserve of the mindless minority, the fact that his family is asking him to sell the fish and chip shop he bought only six months ago is a sorry reflection on society. Rafiq openly admits that he has been far from perfect himself, but for his clear message to be all too readily diluted by some who point to his own failings was inevitable.

Nothing changes his revelations that Yorkshire CCC was racist in its treatment of him and his words must not be forgotten. Otherwise, while the authorities make empty platitudes, the next marginalised player might feel just as hopeless as did Rafiq.
