Gearing up for Pride Month in June

LBGT+ Pride Month takes place across the world in June, in celebration of selfidentity, inclusivity and equality.

While Pride's profile has grown hugely in recent years, the event has been a fixture for over half a century, the first celebration seeing thousands of people marching the streets of New York in 1970, a year after police had raided the Stonewall Inn in the City, an act which sparked riots and became the catalyst for a global movement.

Here in 2022, we know that many of our members will celebrate Pride Month virtually, as they have embraced home working.

So what better way to celebrate Pride Month than with an online LGBT+ speaker and online event?
