Learn more about the Black History Month 365 Fund

Since its launch in 2021 the Black History Month 365 Fund has distributed over £13k to 29 organisations. It's a collaborative fund launched by A2Dominion, Catalyst and MTVH and supported the Centre for Excellence in Community Investment and, here at HDN, we're ready to learn more about the fund at a 2023 launch event on 8th June.

Why don't you join us?

The fund helps community groups to celebrate black history and culture throughout the year and has expanded to include seven Housing Associations, with Clarion, Hyde, Network Homes and Sovereign all joining since the launch. As a result of the growth HACT has produced and impact report of the fund so far, highlighting key successes and case studies, and future recommendations as the fund growth continues.

So we'll be at the event at 11am on the 8th June where we aim to find out more about the Black History Month 365 Fund, and who should get involved in the next round of funding. The event is open to senior leaders and decision makers and anyone interested in racial equality in social housing, and will feature current funders, grant recipients, and community members who will explain how simple it is to join the fund and how straightforward it is for your community partners to apply, and the benefits the fund can bring to your relationships and trust in the community.
